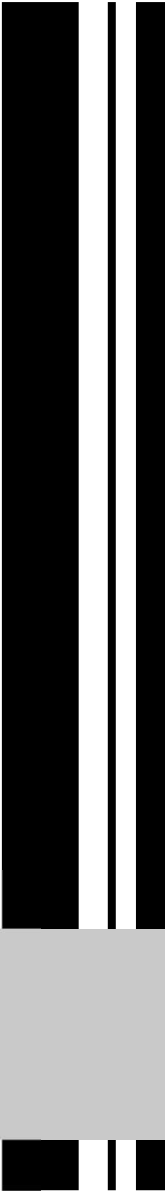




Living on Campus with Resident Education and Development

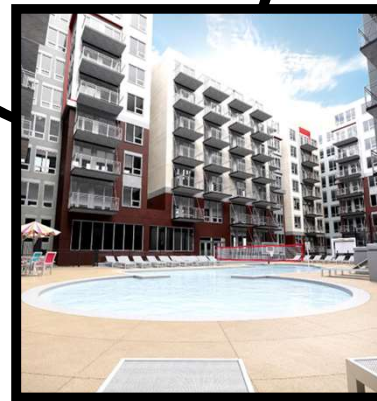

Residential Communities

Individual rooms:

- Mattress-size could vary based on hall
- A desk and chair
- Space for clothing
- Fridge & Microwave
- Trash can
- Internet accessibility
- Basic cable services

Universal residence hall features:

- Non-smoking
- Air conditioned
- Laundry Facilities
- Lounge Areas



Residential Communities

Front desk assistance-could vary per hall:

- 24 hour service
- Resident mailboxes
- Incoming Parcel services
- Complimentary trash bags and toilet paper
- Game table equipment rental (ping pong paddles, billiards sets, etc.)
- Maintenance requests

Lounges and common areas- could vary per hall:

- Televisions
- Pool tables
- Ping pong tables
- Group study space
- Quiet study space

Safety and Security:

- Building Features include - 24/7 card access to residents of that hall, ID, and guest check-in and Campus PD patrol.
- Hall Staff - there are RAs on call daily monitoring the building and supporting policies. There are 24/7 Desk Assistants staff at front desks, as well as 24/7 Professional Staff on-call.
- Fire Protection - Smoke detectors, sprinklers and fire drills
- We recommend that students look into renters' insurance to ensure personal property protection in the communal living space.
